

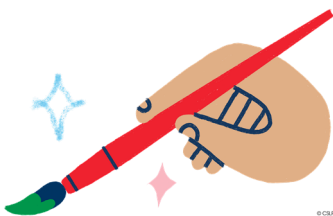


Peach Public Libraries 2025 Summer Reading Program

Turn in one log each week to be entered for a grand prize at the end of our summer reading program on Monday, June 30, 2025 for a total of 4 entries with your name.

Sign-Up Week starts Tuesday, May, 27, 2025 –Saturday, May 31, 2025.

Patrons 0-18 years of age can sign-up through out the month of June, and are encouraged to visit the libraries all summer long. During the summer reading program readers and parents can make reasonable weekly reading goals, log all reading material on their reading logs, and turn in one weekly reading log to our library staff with the participants name. Library staff will start accepting weekly reading logs on Monday, June 9, 2025 and then on each Monday after that for the month of June. Each participant will receive a small weekly incentive when they turn in their reading log. In addition to a weekly incentive, this year each log turned in will give participants a chance to have their name put in a drawing for a final grand prize. There will be three separate age groups during the program and each group will have a separate final grand prize to win. Everyone who participates can have a total of four chances to have their names put in the drawings depending on their age group.

Our first age group is our Storytime group and they will meet on Tuesdays at 11:00 AM at Thomas Public Library in our Fort Valley branch and on Wednesdays at 11:00 AM at Byron Public Library in our Byron branch. This program is intended for children 0 –5 years of age. A caregiver must be present during the program. Parents can log books read, books listened to, and even song names.

Our second group is for readers who are 6 –11 years of age. We will meet at 11:45 AM after each Storytime. Tuesdays at 11:45 AM at Thomas Public Library in our Fort Valley branch and on Wednesday at 11:45 AM at Byron Public Library in our Byron branch. For this age group caregivers do not have to be in the room during our program but are asked to not drop off children or to leave the libraries during this time. Readers can log books read, books listened to, and even magazines looked at. We encourage this group to make a weekly reading goal to challenge themselves, not just weekly but all summer long.

Our last group is for readers who are 12 –15 years of age. This group will meet on Mondays after our Special Guest Program at each library. For this age group, caregivers are not required to stay at the library but to keep in mind the time and duration of the programs so that teens can be picked up. Readers can log the chapters read each week of books, books listened to and magazines looked at.
